Proposed Entry Rules for GTQG 2022 Quilt show

- 1. Entries will be accepted at the November, December 2021 guild meetings or at the January 20, 2022 meeting. Please turn in all your entries at one time.
- 2. Entries may also be mailed to Dot Collins, 2858 Reynolds Lane, Port Neches, Texas 77651
- 3. Entry deadline is January 20, 2022 for both live and mailed turn-ins. No late entries will be accepted.
- 4. Entry fee is \$10 per entry for each entry to be judged. No limit is placed on number of judged entries per person. There is no entry fee for non-judged entries and are limited to three per member.
- 5. All entrants must be a member of the Golden Triangle Quilt Guild. Please be sure to pay your 2022 dues in December 2021 or January 2022 because we will verify membership. If we receive more entries than we have room to exhibit, those who have a higher number of entries will be asked to withdraw one or two quilts with a refund of the related entry fee.
- 6. Delivery of quilts is to Beaumont Civic Center on March 9 between 8 and 11 am.
- 7. Pick up of the quilts will be after the end of the show on Saturday March 12. Time will be announced.
- 8. Each quilt must have a label in a bottom corner on the back of the quilt and must include the name of the quilt, the entrant's name, address, and phone number. You may include any other information you wish.
- 9. Each quilt except for the miniature quilt category must have a 4" sleeve securely stitched to the quilt. If the quilt is longer than 96", place the bottom edge of the sleeve no more than 96" from the bottom of the quilt. Quilts (other than miniature category) received without a sleeve will not be displayed.
- 10. Quilts completed within the previous three years are eligible for entry and may not have previously been judged at a GTQG show to be accepted for judging.
- 11. Each entrant is responsible to insure their quilts. Every effort is made to assure your entry's safety but the chairpersons, Golden Triangle Quilt Guild, or the Beaumont Civic Center can NOT be held liable for loss or damage to your entry (Note: most homeowner's insurance may cover loss but you may wish to verify.)
- 12. **Quilts must be clean and air-freshened**. Check for pet hair and if from a smoking household, please take care to **remove smoke odors prior to delivery** of the quilt.

- 19. Modern quilts
- 20. Baby or juvenile theme quilts
- 21. Miniature quilts, small scale and no larger than 24" square
- 22. Quilters Book Club 2020 challenge (The Wizard of Oz by Frank Baum)
- 23. Small group or Bee quilts name the specific group or bee (these may include but are not limited to round robin, exchanges, theme or fabric challenges)
- 24. Youth made quilts (quiltmaker younger than 18, sponsored by guild member)
