Fun with Fabric Supply List

Bring basic tools...

- scissors for fussy cutting
- scissors suitable for a child to use if you will bring a child
- Background fabric in a light solid or one that reads as a solid, approximately 16 x 20 or the size of your choice. Batting and backing to fit for your quilt sandwich.
- A variety of prints bring your scraps or chunks of fabrics with various sized images large to small from which you can select shapes. All fabric types are suitable...cottons, upholstery, clothing. I will have a pile of fabrics as well, and we will all share
- Pellon 805 Wonder Under or other fusible of your choice
- Glue...fabric stick, Elmer's stick, tacky glue...whatever you prefer. Glue might be best for a child. You may choose which method to use.
- there are several ways to mount finish your portraits. Hand or machine stitching, then we will make a facing binding to finish the edges...or you may choose to make it into a pillow, or to wrap it around a hard backing to frame.

(Some might like to use an erasable marking tool to establish positioning. This is not necessary but bring it if you think it will help you.)
