Create your own neighborhood with houses, trees and stars. Learn paper-piecing for the Quilters Scrap Houses and Trees, and to quickly make Tiny Stars with points that don't have to meet. Looking for a group project everyone will love? This is it! Sample is about 52"--you decide how large your neighborhood grows.

**SUPPLIES:**

Sewing Machine, 1/4" foot very helpful, power cord, foot pedal  
Sewing Thread, light gray or beige  
Scissors for cutting thread while sewing  
Scissors for cutting paper  
Paper and Pencil—for notes  
Stitch Ripper  
Rotary cutter  
Rotary Cutting mat: 12" x 18" if using small pieces, 18" x 24" if cutting yardage  
Rotary Cutting rulers: 6" x 12" or 24" ruler **AND** 6.5" square  
Add-a-Quarter Ruler for paper piecing, this is VERY HELPFUL, 6" size works well

**FABRICS:** the more variety you have, the more interesting the neighborhood--Fat Quarters work well, even smaller pieces can be used in the houses and trees

A wide variety of scraps for Houses and Trees and Stars  
Backgrounds for Stars: a variety of lights  
Sky Fabric for sample size: 1 yard  
Ground Fabric for Houses: ½ yard
