



Categories & Definitions

- **Show Challenge** Pieced quilts should include two elements; some description of PEACE and demonstrate some aspect of SETX. For the PEACE element might be a calm scene, a peace sign or just the word Peace. Whatever you think of when you hear PEACE. For the SETX 'known for', something found only in SETX, i.e. Community Coffee, or alligators, etc. Any size, any technique.
- **Patriotic Challenge** Since America is celebrating the Semiquincentennial this year, this quilt should represent this achievement. The use of red/white/blue and something to indicate freedom. Any size, any technique.

GTQG Block of the Month Challenge (Kathryn Walker/Sharon Richardson)

Bed Quilts Measurements are considered as width is from side to side, length is from top to bottom (as it will be hung).

Large usually known as Queen to King size. 60 - 90" width, 86 - 93" length

Medium usually known as Full or Twin size. 39 - 54" wide, 52 - 75" length

Wall Quilts 30 x 60" or less These quilts are usually made for display on a wall for décor.

Scrap Quilts any size, any theme

Vintage Quilts any size, (Non judged Vintage which would be for show only)

Holiday Themed, any size, any technique

Book Club Quilt, any size These quilts were presented to the Book Club Challenge

Block Of The Month Quilts, pattern/fabric from quilt shop or small group

Art/Pictorial Quilts A quilt made from an original design and includes a significant amount of non—traditional techniques or materials as a major design element, i.e. painting, piecing or applique from an original photo,

Workshop Quilts A quilt (any size) made in a Guild workshop with a specific technique

Hand Quilted A quilt that is pieced and/or quilted by hand.

Modern Quilts A quilt inspired by modern design with minimalism asymmetry, negative space, alternate grid work and or improvisational piecing, high contrast, or many solid-colored fabrics.

Paper Pieced 50% or more of the quilt contains this technique, including EPP.

Applique Quilt 50% or more of the quilt contains this technique.

Novice A quilt by a first time to enter Quilt show quilter. Also, a beginner quilter, learning the basics of the craft. Has completed less than five (5) quilts. This includes hand quilting, longarm (computerized or hand guided), domestic machine or sit down machine.

Youth Made Quilts Quilt made by an 8 to 18 year old and is sponsored by a member of the Guild.

Other Techniques A quilt using a technique such as wholecloth, redwork, collage, yo-yo's, cathedral window and crazy quilts and/or no other category matches.

Bee Quilts This category will represent each of our Guild's Bees. A Bee may choose to have individual quilts from each member of that bee or have a group made quilt from that bee. If individual quilts (made from the same pattern/ such as Pizza box), then six + would be required to be judged. This section is to show our community the value of our Bees and represent this aspect of our Guild. There will be signs for each Bee.
