We will work on piecing the blocks, and then work on applique. You will need to bring your fabrics, pattern, supplies, and sewing machine. If you are interested in purchasing a kit, I have them on my website:

You can also purchase a single pattern if you want to bring your own fabrics, and any applique tools you may need on my website, or at your local quilt shop. Here is a list of the supplies you will need:



- Maker Paper*
- Applique Set* (contains 5 tools: Quilter's Digit, Starch Brush, Appli-Glue, Poke-A-Dots, Needles.)
- Viner Set* (we will be using the ¼" bias tape maker)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Spray starch
- Pressing surface*
- Iron* (I like the Oliso Mini Iron)
- Sewing machine
- Matching threads for applique* (Aurifil 50 wt is preferred)

If you can, cut the following pieces before you come to class: (Do not cut any applique pieces)

From White print for background, cut:

(6) rectangles 8 ½" x 32 ½"

(2) rectangles 8 ½" x 16 ½"

(4) squares 8 ½" x 8 ½"

From assorted coral and red prints, cut:

(14) squares 10" x 10"

From assorted gray prints, cut:

(14) squares 10" x 10"
