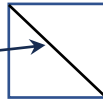

MAKING HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

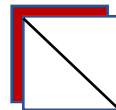
Use a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance when sewing.

Using 5 inch squares:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 92 – 5-inch light print squares.



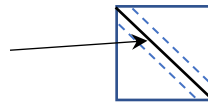
2. Place a marked light square right sides together on top of 5-inch dark square.



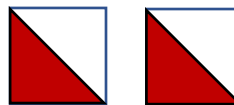
3. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on both sides of line.



4. Cut on the drawn line to make 2 – large half-square triangles.



5. Trim up to 4-1/2 inches. You should have 184 units.



Using 3 inch squares:

Repeat the above steps using the 3-inch squares

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 52 – 3-inch light print squares.
2. Place a marked light square right sides together on top of 3-inch dark square.
3. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on both sides of line.
4. Cut on the drawn line to make 2 – small half-square triangles.
5. Trim up to 2-1/2 inches. You should have 104 units.
